Brent's Chicken Taco Soup

Let's turn making Brent's Chicken Taco Soup into a delightful culinary adventure! Get ready to whip up a batch of this flavorful soup that'll have your taste buds doing a happy dance.

Ingredients:

- 2 tbsp butter
- 4 cups cooked/rotisserie chicken, shredded
- 2 tbsp olive oil
- 1 red bell pepper, chopped
- One large onion, chopped
- Three large carrots, chopped
- 1 whole bag of celery, chopped
- 6 cups chicken broth
- 4 (10-ounce) cans of Ro-tel diced tomatoes and green chilies with juices
- 2 (14-ounce) cans of black beans, drained and rinsed

If you're watching your salt intake, opt for low-sodium broth.

For extra creamy goodness, make sure your cream cheese is super soft before adding it to the soup.

- 2 (12-ounce) cans of corn, drained
- 1 can of green chilies
- 1 or 2 roasted fresh green chilies, chopped
- 1 tsp chicken bouillon powder
- 1 tsp paprika
- 1 tsp onion powder
- 2 packages of taco seasoning
- 2 tsp Tony Chachere's seasoning (add more as needed)
- 16 ounces cream cheese (softened)
- Salt and pepper to taste
- Toppings (optional): shredded Mexican cheese blend, avocado, cilantro, tortilla strips, etc.

Brent's Chicken Taco Soup

Instructions:

- 1. Let's kick things off by cooking the chicken in butter until it's perfectly golden brown. Remove the chicken and any excess fat from the pan.
- 2. In a soup pot, heat olive oil over medium-high heat. Add onions and all the chopped fresh vegetables, and sauté for 5 minutes or until they're nice and tender.
- 3. Now, pour in the chicken broth and add the Ro-tel diced tomatoes, black beans, corn, chicken bouillon powder, paprika, onion powder, taco seasoning, Tony Chachere's seasoning, and green chilies. Stir everything together.
- 4. Crank up the heat and bring the soup to a boil. Once it's bubbling away, reduce the heat and let it simmer gently (uncovered) for 5 minutes. While the soup works its magic, get your toppings ready.

- 5. Cut the cream cheese into smaller pieces and add them to the soup. Keep stirring until the cream cheese melts completely and becomes one with the soup.
- 6. Time to reunite the shredded chicken with its flavorful friends! Stir in the chicken and let it mingle with the other ingredients for another 5 to 7 minutes until it's warmed through.
- 7. Give the soup a taste and season with salt and pepper as needed.
- 8. Ladle the soup into bowls and get creative with your toppings. Whether you're loading up on cheese, avocado, cilantro, or tortilla strips, make it your own!

Feel free to switch out the diced tomatoes, but don't forget to add some diced green chilies for that extra kick.

This recipe serves 4 to 6, depending on how hungry you are and how generously you top your soup bowls.
